The voting by secret ballot and referendum ballot will be held between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Friday May 7th, 2021 at the Southport Town Hall. No open meeting will be held that day due to restrictions in the mandated state of emergency in place for Covid 19.

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify the voters of the Town of Southport, in said County, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Southport Town Hall in said Town on May 7, AD 2021, at 10 O'clock in the forenoon to act on the following articles to wit:

Article 1. To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Article 2. To elect by secret ballot a MEMBER AT LARGE for three years for the Boothbay Region Water District

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to seek bonding, not to exceed \$2,480,000.00, for the purpose of creating a Southport owned FIBER OPTIC SYSTEM to allow access to high speed internet to every Southport household and business.

Article 4. To hear and accept the minutes taken at this meeting by the Town Clerk, act or transact anything related hereto.

The Registrar of Voters holds office hours at the Southport Town Office from 8:00 am to 12:30 pm Monday through Thursday, and 6 pm to 8 pm Monday evenings. A person who is not a registered voter may not vote in any election or town meeting.
